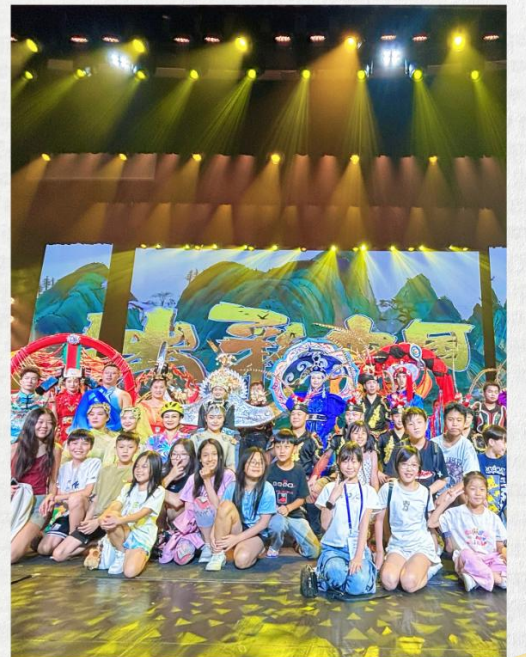

Beijing Camp Introduction

The camp is set within two world-renowned historic landmarks — making it China's first international summer camp inside millennium-old historic buildings.

Imperial Academy (Guozijian) — 700 Years of Royal Scholarship

Founded in 1287, this was China's highest institution of learning for centuries, where emperors personally lectured. Remarkably preserved after 700+ years — and now, our classroom.



Beijing Museum of Ancient Architecture — The Emperor's Farmland

Built in 1420, the same age as the Forbidden City. Ming and Qing emperors performed ceremonial plowing here each spring. Inscribed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2024. A rare oasis of calm in the heart of Beijing — and our campers' home for learning and activities.
